### Regulation

### FLORBALL

19.05. - 21.05.2017.

#### 1. Competition Organizers:

- 1.1. Competition will be organized by Latvian the University Sports Federation (LUSF) and lead by Sports Service Centre of Latvian University (LUSSC).

#### 2. Competition Proceedings:

- 2.1. Competition will be held in accordance with **XXXIII SELL Student Games** Rules and IFF Competition Regulations and Rules. The Playing System will be announced after the entry deadline.
- 2.2. The competition will take place between **19.05.2017** and **21.05.2017** in the **Elektrum Olympic Centre** (EOC) Riga, Grostonas street 6b. Preliminary rounds and elimination matches will take place in the first two days of the competition (19.05.2017 and 20.05.2017). The Finals (determining both the first and third places) will take place on 21.05.2017.
- 2.3. The maximum number of participants in a team - 17 players and 3 official team representatives.
- 2.4. The competition takes place in men's competition.

#### 3. Competition Format:

- 3.1. 2 x 20min (continuously running clock) time in group games and play-offs and 3 x 15min (continuously running clock) time in games for the first place and third place. Tournament organizers can change the time format depending on the number of participating teams. If the match ends in a draw, each team will take 3 penalty shots to determine the winner. In the group stages a win gives the team 3 points, a win after penalty shots – 2 points, a loss after penalty shots – 1 point, and a loss in regulation time – 0 points. If two or more teams have the same number of points after the group matches, the standings are decided by their performance in the following (in decreasing order of importance):
  - head to head performances between the two or more teams with equal number of points;
  - the total goal difference over all group matches by the team;
  - the number of goals scored in all group matches by the team;
  - the total number of penalty minutes in all group matches by the team (team with fewest penalty minutes being the winner);
  - 3 penalty shots.
- 3.2. A draw in play-off games and games for the 1st and 3rd place will be followed by 3 penalty shots by each team to decide the winner.

#### 4. Medical Support:

4.1. Competition Organizers will provide first aid at the competitions for all accredited persons.
