

XXXIII SELL STUDENT GAMES Rules and regulations BADMINTON

19.05. -21.05.2017

1. Venue and time:

- 1.1. Riga (exact venue to be specified)
- 1.2. The tournament will take place on 19.05. -20.05.2017

2. Tournament events:

- 2.1. Men's singles
- 2.2. Women's singles
- 2.3. Men's doubles
- 2.4. Women's doubles
- 2.5. Mixed doubles

3. Regulations:

- 3.1. The tournament is organised according to the rules and regulations of the XXXIII SELL games.
- 3.2. The tournament is held according to the Competition Regulations of the Badminton World Federation, where a match consists of best of three games and a game is won by the side which first scores 21 points.
- 3.3. Players must wear sports clothing appropriate for badminton and shoes that do not damage the floor.

4. Tournament format:

- 4.1. The tournament format will be determined depending on the number of participants.
 - 4.1.1. By default matches are at first played in subgroups, afterwards with a single-elimination system.
- 4.2. Semi-finalists in singles and doubles will receive bronze medals.

5. Participants:

- 5.1. Each higher education institution may register a maximum of 4 women and 4 men.
- 5.2. In doubles only students of the same higher education institution may compete.

6. The draw:

- 6.1. The players shall be drawn in groups and brackets through 3 pots:
 - 6.1.1. Players who are in the BWF world ranking shall be seeded in the 1st pot.
 - 6.1.2. Players who are only in the BWF world ranking and BEC junior ranking shall be seeded in the 2nd pot.
 - 6.1.3. Players who are not present in any international ranking shall be seeded in the 3rd pot.

7. Equipment:

7.1. Matches shall take place on wooden surface sports halls floors with colored lines.

- 7.2. Players shall use their own shuttlecocks that are not of a worse quality than Yonex 20.
- 7.3. There shall be an equipment shop at the venue as well as stringing service.

8. Umpiring:

- 8.1. Matches shall be officiated by umpires that have been appointed by the Latvian Badminton federation.
- 8.2. Starting with semi-finals matches shall be also officiated by service judges and at least two line judges.
