

XXXIII SELL STUDENT SPORT GAMES Regulations BEACH VOLLEYBALL

- **1. Organizers**: "O SANDS" beach volleyball in cooperation with the Latvian University Sport Alliance.
- 2. Goal: To stimulate interest in beach volleyball competitions between students of various universities. Develop interest and increase the proficiency levels through beach volleyball competitions between various countries' students. Find students who have interest in sport and introduce them to others with similar interests, hoping for future cooperation. Determine the best beach volleyball players among the participants, and the university where the best sportspeople attend.

3. Date/Time and location:

3.1. 19.05. - 21.05.2017 Rīga, Hanzas Street 14A, O-Sands outdoor beach volleyball park. The day of the tournament the number of teams participating will be known. The tournament can extend through 20.05.2017.

4. Participants:

- 4.1. The participants in the tournament are students and graduates from no earlier than 2016. (more detailed information can be found with the centralized XXXIII SELL regulations).
- 4.2. 32 teams of men and women, from each SELL country 4 teams, other countries 2 teams.
- 4.3. The number of participating teams from each SELL country can be enlarged if by 21.04.2017 there are not yet 32 registered teams.
- **5. Tournament procedures:** The tournament takes place in two rounds: the group "round robin" and the final grouping by the "one minus" system. The number of groups in each round, as well as the number of teams to continue to the next round, and the point system will be determined based on the number of participating teams.
- 6. Officiating: The officiating will occur based on the international FIVB rules. http://www.fivb.org
- 7. Signing Up and Registration: this is to occur electronically at the website www.sellgames2017.eu (the Registration form is to be completed by a representative of the respective university) until 21.04.2017.
- 8. Uniforms: All members of each team must be in the same uniform.
- **9. Awards**: The winning teams will receive a trophy and medals, as well as prizes from the sponsors.
- **10. Medical considerations:** Each tournament participant through registering declares that they are responsible for their own health standing, and fitness to compete. During the tournament there will be on-site medical staff.
